- To identify some characteristics of the four countries – and their capital cities – of the UK
- To identify key topographical features (e.g. hills, mountains, coasts and rivers) of an area of the UK
- To identify land-use patterns of an area of the UK
- To know about seasonal weather patterns in the UK
- To know about daily weather patterns in the UK
- To know that Devon is the only county with 2 coastlines

## Bringing it Home

- To know about the seasonal and daily weather patterns of our local area
- To know the topographical features (e.g. hills, mountains, coasts and rivers) seen in Crediton
- To know how to follow a route on a map, going around school
- To know how to draw a simple map of part of Crediton, showing some of its geographical features
- To know the appropriate symbols to use as a simple key for a map of part of Crediton
- To know about important crafts in Crediton's history

- To know that a photo is a way of recording what has been seen
- To know how to use a camera or device to take a photograph of what they have seen on a fieldwork trip
- To know how the countries of the UK differ – accents, languages, traditions, dance and songs
