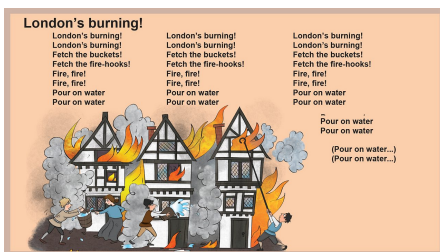
Imagine you are writing a diary during the time of the Great Fire of Crediton.
