IMPORTANT REMINDERS

ADMISSION TO SECONDARY SCHOOL

If your child is in Year 6, you will be thinking about the most appropriate secondary school for your child. It is important to note that you must apply for a secondary school place before 31st October 2023. If your child's medical needs have changed over the summer, please provide this information to the school office.

CHURCH CAR PARK

The church are concerned about people parking on the narrow street, next to the milk factory, rather than in the car park. This is proving a potential obstacle for emergency service access to the church. They are also worried about the parking within the car park and families not using the bays correctly to maximise the available parking. Can I ask that we address this please as it would be disappointing if this access was removed.

WALKING TO AND FROM SCHOOL

It is important that all pupils in EYFS to Year 4 are walked to and from school please. We allow Year 5 and Year 6 pupils to do this, with parental consent, but feel it is too much of a risk for the younger children to do this independently.

FREE SCHOOL MEALS

If you think you might be eligible for Free School Meals and consequently for the Holiday vouchers of £15 per week per child, please log on to the DCC Citizen's Portal (link in parentmail sent earlier this week). If you could do this as soon as possible (preferably before the end September) this will ensure you don't miss out on meals and vouchers your child/ren might be entitled to and also that the school gets additional funding to help your child/ren with their educational needs.
