#### FIRST AID POLICY

I want to draw your attention to our 1st aid policy, which I have added with this newsletter. Not all schools have a 1st aid policy, but we have one which clearly defines the approach that we take at school. Please take a moment to read the policy.

Important Messages:

- Following a head bump, If your child is in EYFS—a green first aid note will come home with the child, as well as contact being made at collection. You will also receive notification by text.
- Following a head bump, if your child is in Year 1 to Year 6 you will be notified via text message. Please can you ensure that you check your phone to ensure that these messages are not missed.
- If the headbump, or your child's condition following a first aid incident, is a concern, we will phone you and ask for advice on how to proceed. We may ask you to collect your child. If you receive a phonecall asking for this, we would be grateful for your support in this matter.
