UPDATE

We have enjoyed another busy week at school, as we head towards Easter. I know the children in Year 4 are really looking forward to their Great Potheridge House residential next week.

BRITISH SCIENCE WEEK



We have really enjoyed British Science Week 2024. Each year group looked at different areas of Science within their lessons and explored the idea of what makes a Scientist:

- EYFS have carried out daily experiments over the course of the week. These have included watching the impact of water on skittles and studying the impact of putting celery in coloured water.
- Year 1 have investigated time through the seasons.
 They looked at the changes to trees and the weather.
 They have made season wheels.
- Year 2 have been learning about nutrition and healthy eating. They have used 'Now Press Play' to explore different foods within the food groups.
- Year 3 have been studying the different parts of plants.
- Year 4 have carried out an experiment involving pendulums. They wanted to find out what happens if you make the string of the pendulum shorter or make the weight on the end heavier. Some of them tried to make an accurate timer by making the pendulum swing twenty times in twenty seconds.
- Year 5 have looked at conductors and insulators within one class, while the other class looked at materials which are soluble and insoluble through investigation.
- Year 6 have been looked at electricity and the components of a working electrical circuit.

SPORT @ HAYWARD'S

Y3-6 had a very enjoyable evening of football at Crediton Leisure Centre. We played against Newton St. Cyres, initially as Y5/6 and Y3/4 teams, and then mixed the teams up. The year 5/6 team showed great resilience against a talented Newton team and the Y3/4 team used their lightning pace, ball control and calmness under pressure to achieve a positive result. There were excellent goals, commitment and some shining examples of sportsmanship throughout both teams. Thanks to Mrs Poole for accompanying the team and to Josh Poole (A former pupil) for refereeing so well.



On Monday 11th March, Hayward's hosted a netball tournament for Year 3 and 4 children run by Primary Sports. The tournament involved 8 local schools.

The children played extremely well, with some amazing interceptions from James and some great scoring from Luke. As a result, Hayward's finished first in their group and therefore progressed to the final against Winkleigh..

The final was hard fought with lots of scoring opportunities, great communication between players and excellent resilience when Winkleigh scored. In the end, Winkleigh won 1-0 but Hayward's showed brilliant sportmanship throughout and were a real credit to the school. As a result of coming 2nd, the children were awarded medals! Well done!
