FOOTBALL SUCCESS YEAR 5 and YEAR 6



An intrepid squad of Year 5 and Year 6 children ventured into Exeter to participate in the Local Area Finals of the 'English Football League Kids Cup'.

A win in the first game set the tone for the day and at the end of our 7 group games we were second in the table, having the same points as the group leader but having scored 1 less goal. We advanced to the Quarter finals.

Our defence was superb, with Hayward's being the only team not to concede a goal in regulation play throughout the entire festival. This was a testament to the determination and teamwork shown by the team.

A tense 0-0 draw in the Quarter Final, resulted in a penalty shootout which saw some excellent strikes and high quality saves which helped us advance to the semi-finals. Alas, despite our best efforts and some wonderful saves, we were on the wrong side of a penalty shoot out and were knocked out.

The children showed high levels of commitment, skill, game understanding and a sense of fun which made it a fantastic day to be involved in. Well done to everybody involved!

CARDIO DRUMMING
