Our Commitment as a School

We will:

- Act with integrity, honesty and compassion in all our interactions.
- Provide a safe, nurturing, respectful and supportive learning environment.
- Deliver a high-quality education tailored to each child's needs.
- Communicate openly and professionally with parents and carers.
- Keep families informed about their child's progress and involve them in decisions about their learning.
- Offer support and guidance when concerns or challenges arise.
- Respond to a child's needs, whether emotionally, socially or academically and work with families to put in place appropriate provision.

Our Commitment as Family

We will:

- Support the school and work in partnership with staff, recognising that we are a team around the child.
- Speak respectfully about the school, staff and pupils, and not undermine the school by making negative comments in front of our child.
- Raise any concerns directly with the school in a calm, honest and constructive manner, using appropriate channels rather than social media, and engage with the support, advice and guidance offered.
- Raise any concerns at an appropriate time, recognising that the morning is a time where teachers are settling children for the start of the school day, and use Senior Leaders, available on the school gate as required.
- Strive for excellent punctuality and attendance whilst supporting our children in being 'ready for learning' by ensuring that they are rested for the school day and have an age-appropriate bedtime.
- Support the school's behaviour policy, including attending meetings requested by the school, and the school's home-learning policy, helping children develop good practises and ensure that home-learning is completed on time.
- Support the school's smartphone ban and help ensure that my child is not accessing computer games/internet sites/social media platforms/ inappropriately aged apps or TV programs that are not suitable for their age.

- Work collaboratively to support the child's academic progress, wellbeing and personal development.
- Model respectful relationships and positive communication.
