You may remember that last summer the school held an exhibition of the childrens' work linked to 'A Regatta on the Grand Canal' by Canaletto.

We are pleased to announce that we have been chosen, as one of only two schools in the South West of England, to have our work displayed at the National Gallery in London. Work produced by our current Year 6 children was selected from over 79,000 children from 362 schools across the country and will be displayed there from the 4th June to 31st August 2026. The exhibition will showcase the work of pupils from 35 schools across the UK.
