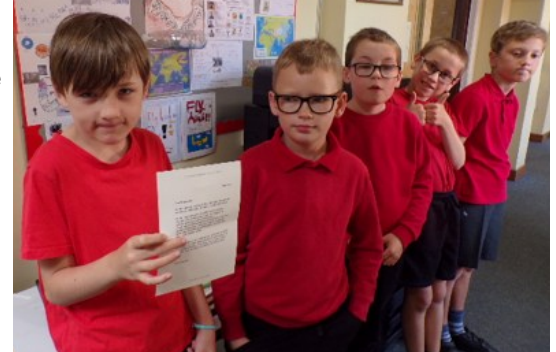
EGYPTIAN DAY
